GUEST PREACHER

The Very Revd David duPlantier has served as the 13th Dean and 27th Rector of Christ Church Cathedral, New Orleans, Louisiana since February of 2002.

Born in Louisville, Kentucky, he earned a BA in Economics/Political Science/International Studies from Miami University (Oxford, Ohio). Following graduation, he worked in health care marketing in Washington, D.C. and Chicago Illinois. In 1993, duPlantier was awarded a M.Div. from The General Theological Seminary of the Episcopal Church in New York City where he also served as Seminarian on the staff of Trinity Church (Wall Street).

In the fall of 2005, he formed a partnership between Christ Church Cathedral and the New Orleans Jazz Orchestra which led to the commissioning of a major work entitled "All the Saints" which was premiered at Christ Church Cathedral in November 2005 and received national acclaim as the cultural rebirth of the City following the devastation of Hurricane Katrina several months earlier. The New Orleans Jazz Orchestra received a Grammy Award for the Album version of the work.

In 2009, he was the recipient of the Distinguished Alumnus Award from the General Theological Seminary.

Dean duPlantier is married to Karla Sikaffy duPlantier, and has two adult children.


