A brief bio of Dr Lee:

LEE Wai Yung, Ph.D., AAMFT
Honorary Associate Professor at the University of Hong Kong, Clinical Director of the Asian Academy of Family Therapy and Shanghai Aitia Family Institute. Much of Dr Lee’s research focused on dispersing the many myths about Asian Chinese families, as well as developing a framework for a culturally relevant approach in working with not only Chinese families, but also families of the world. Her research on children’s response to parental conflicts has been considered ground-breaking in the family therapy field in which she has expanded the knowledge and technology to the studying of children from divorce and trans-generational families.
